It also guides EARN's general course of operations, assists in the execution of related work plans and fosters the collaboration of EARN's various members.

The EARN Steering Committee is currently recruiting new members. The membership term is 3 years, with an option to extend for a second term. Our application process will involve the submission of a letter of interest, your resume and a reference letter, followed by an interview process.
